

ORDINANCE

Anmoore

ESTABLISHING THE FORM OF GOVERNMENT OF THE TOWN OF ANMOORE

WHEREAS, the Town of Anmoore was incorporated November 13, 1950, and is a Class IV Town as defined in the West Virginia Code §8-1-3; and

WHEREAS, the form of government of the Town of Anmoore has been unclear, and a subject of dispute, for many years; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Anmoore has the authority to, and may by ordinance, determine and prescribe the powers and duties of municipal officers, pursuant to West Virginia Code § 8-5-11; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Anmoore desires to determine and prescribe that the form of government of the Town of Anmoore shall be the "Mayor-Council Plan", as defined in West Virginia Code §8-3-2. Under this plan, the Mayor and Council together shall be the "governing body" and the "administrative authority", as such terms are defined in West Virginia Code §8-1-2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANMOORE, WEST VIRGINIA, THAT:

Section One. The form of government of the Town of Anmoore shall be the "Mayor-Council Plan". Under this plan, the Mayor and Council together shall be both the "governing body" and the "administrative authority".

Section Two. For purposes of this Ordinance "governing body" shall mean the Mayor and Council acting together. As the governing body, the Mayor and Council acting together shall have the authority to enact ordinances and determine the public policy of the Town of Anmoore.

Section Three. For purposes of this Ordinance "administrative authority" shall mean the Mayor and Council acting together. As the administrative authority, the Mayor and Council acting together shall have the authority to conduct and manage the affairs of the Town of Anmoore.

Section Four.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage.
