

ARTICLE 103
Competitive Bidding

103.01 When required

103.01 WHEN REQUIRED

(a) Competitive bidding is required for the acquisition of materials, supplies, services or equipment, the cost of which is expected to exceed the sum of twenty five thousand dollars. (\$25,000)

(b) Council shall have the right to accept or reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities therein and in doing so Council is authorized to consider, not only the amount of each bid, but the responsibility of the bidder, including the bidder's capital resources, skill and judgment and the anticipated quality of materials and performance of services and contracts.


(c) Competitive bidding is required for all construction projects.

(d) In the event an emergency occurs and a purchase must be made immediately, the council is authorized to make this decision. In this event, the bidding process would not apply.


(e) Competitive bidding for attorney services will not be required. The Town Attorney must be appointed by Mayor and approved by Council.
