120.01 TIME AND PLACE OF REGULAR MEETINGS

The regular meetings of the Council shall be held on the 1st and 3rd Monday of each month and such time and place may be designated by Council.

120.02 ORGANIZATION

Council shall be presided over at its meetings by the mayor, or in his absence, by the Recorder, or, in the absence of both the mayor and the Recorder, by the members of Council shall be necessary to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. No member of Council shall vote upon any ordinance, order, measure, resolution or proposition, in which he may be interested other than as a citizen of such municipality.

120.03 MAYOR AND RECORDER MAY VOTE

Mayor and Recorder shall have votes as members of the governing body and in case of a tie, the presiding officer at the time shall cast the tie-breaking vote, unless he has previously voted.

RECORDS; MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS; VOTING

(a) Council shall cause to be kept, in a well-bound book, an accurate record of all of its proceedings, ordinances, orders, bylaws, acts, resolutions, rules and regulations which shall be fully indexed and open to inspection by anyone who is required to pay taxes to the Town.

(b) At each meeting of Council, a journal of the proceedings of the last meeting shall be read, and corrected, if erroneous, and signed by the presiding officer for the time being; provided, that the reading of the journal of the proceedings of the last meeting may be dispensed with by majority vote of Council if the members thereof have received and examined a copy of the journal or a synopsis thereof prior to the meeting at which the journal is signed. Upon the call of any member, the yeas and nays on any questions shall be taken and recorded in the journal.

(c) An audio copy, if available, of each Council meeting of the Town of Anmoore shall be kept at the Town Hall for a period of one (1) year.

SALARY OF COUNCIL

(a) Each Councilman duly elected and serves as Councilman for the Town of Anmoore shall receive the sum of \$100.00 per month for services rendered by said Councilman to the Town of Anmoore, annual income \$1200.00.

(b) Each Councilman duly elected and serving as Councilman for the Town of Anmoore must maintain in good faith the office for which elected and must materially participate a minimum of 2 hours per-month to carry out the duties for which elected.


(c) Councilmembers who miss more than three (3) consecutive regularly scheduled council meetings during their current term will be considered in-active and will not receive their monthly compensation until said Councilmember returns to the regularly scheduled meetings.
